



Learn the basics of the Procreate app and how to digitize your artwork. iPads will be provided. You are also welcome to bring your own iPad with the Procreate app.



We're excited to share that we've made some changes in our Kids Room spaces. As part of our ongoing practice to review community needs, we discovered an opportunity to better serve elementary-age kids and their families by providing dedicated spaces to support engagement and learning.

The BOOMbox is now focused on grades 3–6. This space will help kids engage with the library independently through creating and making, volunteering, playing games, and other activities that build connections with their peers and the Skokie community.





For K–2 kids, we've added to the Activity Room. It now includes a reading nook and games to help develop reading, writing, and other skills. These activities will be available after school on most days. We hope this room can now be used as a multisensory space where kids can interact with adults to read, try new learning tools, and explore educational activities in engaging ways.
