

# Embroidery Machine Approved Fabrics List

For all material that will be embroidered in the Studio, the stabilizer must be hooped first.

Lightly run a glue stick over the stabilizer and attach the item you want to embroider. We use water-soluble glue sticks in the Studio, so it should not damage the fabric.

The top stabilizer is used when an extra layer is needed over the item that you are embroidering. This will most commonly be used with towels since there is a chance that the terry cloth will push through the embroidery stitches without the top stabilizer.

## Approved Fabrics:

- 100% cotton
  - Natural woven fabrics
  - Jersey
  - Nylon
  - Muslin
- Burlap
- Canvas
  - Purses, backpacks, and Sports Gear
- Denim
- Faux Fur
- Felt (cannot exceed 1/8" of an inch thickness)
- Fleece (cannot exceed 1/8 of an inch thickness)
- Leather (cannot exceed 1/8 of an inch thickness)
- Pleather (cannot exceed 1/8 of an inch thickness)
- Ribbon
- Silk
- Suede (cannot exceed 1/8 of an inch thickness)
- Terry Cloth/Towels
- Vinyl (cannot exceed 1/8 of an inch thickness)
