
Going to Skokie Public Library

There are a lot of things to do in the Teen Room.




I can play games and do puzzles.

There are study rooms for doing quiet activities.




I can ask a staff person to help me sign into a study room.

This is the Sensory Break Room.




If I am feeling stressed, I can ask to use the Sensory Break Room. I can change the color of the lights and listen to relaxing sounds until I feel calm.

I can use the stairs or the elevator.




I can use computers in the Computers area.




I can make things in the Studio, from toys to music.
